JOB SUMMARY Provides for the maintenance of a safe and clean environment. Performs various housekeeping tasks, meal preparation and companionship activities for clients in their residences.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Performs homemaking activities which include (*but are not limited to*): vacuuming, dusting, sweeping or mopping floors, doing dishes, changing bed linens, doing laundry, and cleaning bathrooms.

Prepares meals and snacks according to instructions. May shop for groceries.

Provides companionship for the client. This includes accompanying client on walks, trips to social/recreational activities, assistance with hobbies, etc.

QUALIFICATIONS

- High school graduate or G.E.D. certificate preferred.
- Completion of a written Competency Evaluation.
- Ability to read, write, speak and understand English as needed for the job.
- Possession of a valid driver's license and use of an insured automobile or access to adequate transportation for the job.

Caregivers must spend at least 80% of their work time providing fellowship, care and protection for clients. Any general household work must be less than 20% of the caregiver's working time during each shift.
